Interim Flows Update: On Friday, March 4, releases from Friant Dam increased to 700 cubic feet per second (cfs).

On February 1, the San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) resumed water releases, called Interim Flows, from Friant Dam, near Fresno, into the San Joaquin River. Please check the website for updates.

NOTE: The release schedule for flows is subject to change based on hydrology conditions as the water year progresses and coordination with the Settling Parties and the Restoration Administrator. If necessary, additional releases will be made for flood management that could exceed the anticipated Interim Flow releases.
