## **Field Activity Advisory Levee and Ground Topographic Surveys June 28 – July 3, 2012**

**Who:** California Department of Water Resources (DWR), Provost & Pritchard (P&P)

**What:** DWR's consultant, Provost & Pritchard, will conduct levee and outside ground topographic surveys June 28 through July 3 in Reach 2A. This work will help evaluate the levee stability and seepage issues upstream of the Chowchilla Bifurcation Structure in support of the San Joaquin River Restoration Program. A two-person crew (P&P) will be surveying about 27 cross-sections located within a 3 mile reach immediately upstream of bifurcation structure. DWR staff may be present for some of the work.

**Where:** Reach 2A, 3 miles upstream of the Chowchilla Bifurcation Structure

**When:** June 28 – July 3, 2012
